

Day of Surgery

- Patients under the age of 18 MUST be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian who must remain at Mission Surgery Center until the patient is discharged.
- Bring required payments for surgical services or any deductible or co-payment required by your insurance company at the time of your admission. We will accept a personal check, Visa, Discover, MasterCard or cash.
- Bring your completed Pre-Admission Questionnaire found in your packet if you were not pre-admitted.
- You will be taken to the Holding Area and seen by a Pre-operative Nurse and anesthesiologist. One parent, spouse or friend can remain with the patient during this time.
- Following your surgery, you will be taken to the Recovery Room. Your parent, spouse or friend will be notified when you have been taken to the Recovery Room and can join you individually once you are awake and alert, and stay with you until you are ready to go home.
- Arrangements MUST be made for someone to transport you home after your surgery. You will not be able to drive and you cannot take public transportation.
- Please make sure you have all primary and secondary insurance information (i.e. cards, forms) at the time of your admission so that we can photocopy them.
- Please do not bring valuables as we cannot be responsible for them.
- Please do not wear contact lenses or other items that may get lost.
